

Germany Hosts the 2006 Soccer World Cup (Retrospective account, 2011)

Abstract

This report from the ZDF television program "Terra X" looks back at the 2006 World Cup in Germany, which became a major international PR success for Germany. Always concerned about how it is perceived abroad, Germany presented itself as a cosmopolitan, culturally diverse and friendly host of the tournament. The German national team, which itself now reflected an increasingly diverse society and played attractive soccer all the way to the semi-finals, delighted both German and international audiences.
