

Gregor Gysi and Oskar Lafontaine (September 10, 2005)

Abstract

On June 10, 2005, the left-wing alliance formed by the Left Party/PDS and the WASG [*Wahlalternative für Arbeit und soziale Gerechtigkeit* or Electoral Alternative for Labor and Social Justice] announced that Gregor Gysi (top) and Oskar Lafontaine (bottom) would run as its top candidates. After the 2005 Bundestag elections, in which the Left Party/PDS won a respectable 8.7 percent of the second votes, Gysi and Lafontaine were appointed co-chairmen of the alliance's Bundestag faction.
