

Kurt Biedenkopf at a CDU Campaign Event in Saxony (October 1990)

Abstract

On October 14, 1990, the five new federal states held their very first *Landtag* [state parliament] elections. Taken at a CDU campaign event in Borna (Saxony) in October 1990, this photograph shows the top CDU candidate for the *Landtag* elections, Kurt Biedenkopf. The CDU emerged as the clear victor in the elections in Saxony, Saxony-Anhalt, Mecklenburg-West Pomerania, and Thuringia. As a result, the West German candidate Biedenkopf became prime minister of Saxony. [Note: the CDU poster on podium reads: "Yes to Germany. Yes to the Future."]
