

The Last “Monday Demonstration” in Leipzig (March 12, 1990)

Abstract

A participant in the "Monday demonstration" in Leipzig on March 12, 1990 (the last Monday demonstration for the duration) holds a sign that reads: “Even after the last demonstration – We are the people – We are one people.” Six days before the first free elections to the East German *Volkskammer*, the desire for reunification with the Federal Republic of Germany was still running strong among East Germans.
