

Anton von Werner, *Prince Bismarck at the Bundesrat Desk, Giving a Speech* (1888)

Abstract

This painting by Anton von Werner (1843–1915) appears to be based on a sketch entitled *Bismarck in the Reichstag*, which was dated December 1, 1885. From 1871 onward, Bismarck wore his Cuirassier uniform whenever he appeared in the Reichstag and at most other public events in Berlin.
