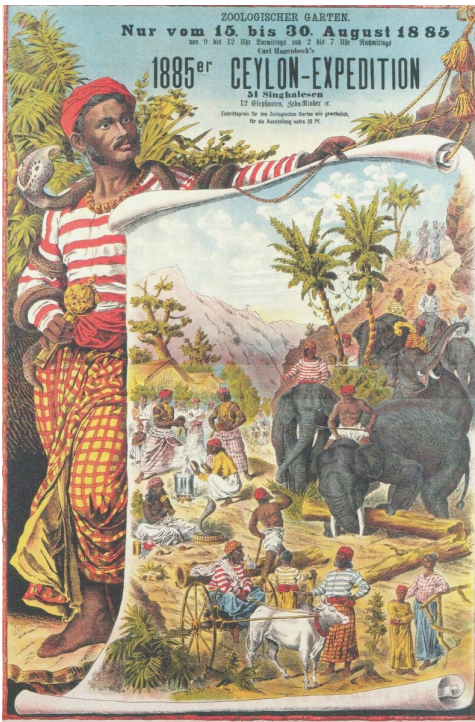


Poster Advertising “Carl Hagenbeck’s 1885 Ceylon Expedition” (1885)

Abstract

This poster advertised another one of Carl Hagenbeck’s human zoo exhibits (*Völkerschauen*) staged at the Berlin Zoo. This show featured indigenous people from Ceylon (today’s Sri Lanka) along with animals such as elephants and zebus in order to present a replica of the “natural environment.”
