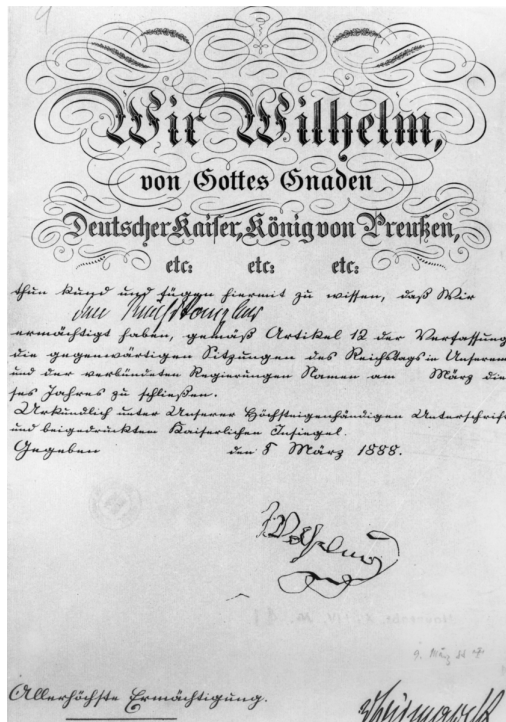


Kaiser Wilhelm I's Last Official Signature (March 8, 1888)

Abstract

This facsimile shows the last state document ever signed by Kaiser Wilhelm I. It was signed on March 8, 1888, and the Kaiser died the following day. The document authorized Bismarck to conclude the current legislative session of the Reichstag.
