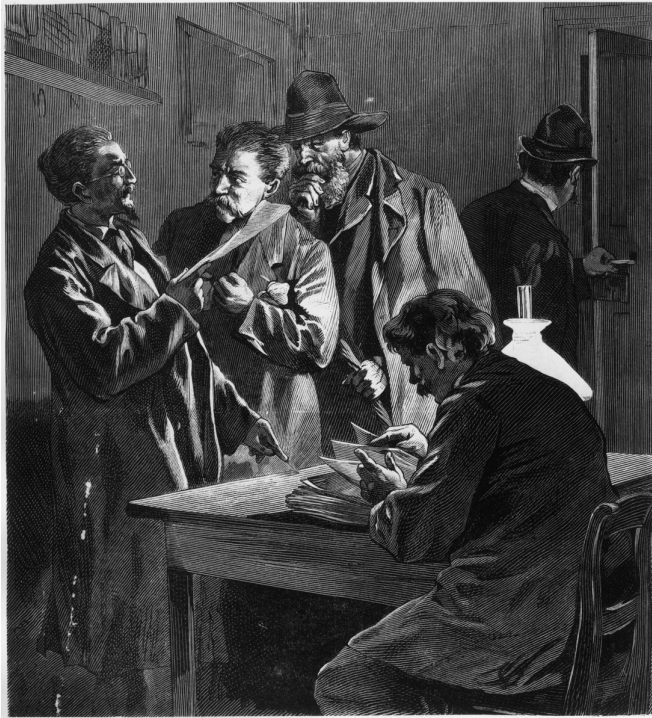


Socialist “Conspirators” (1879)
