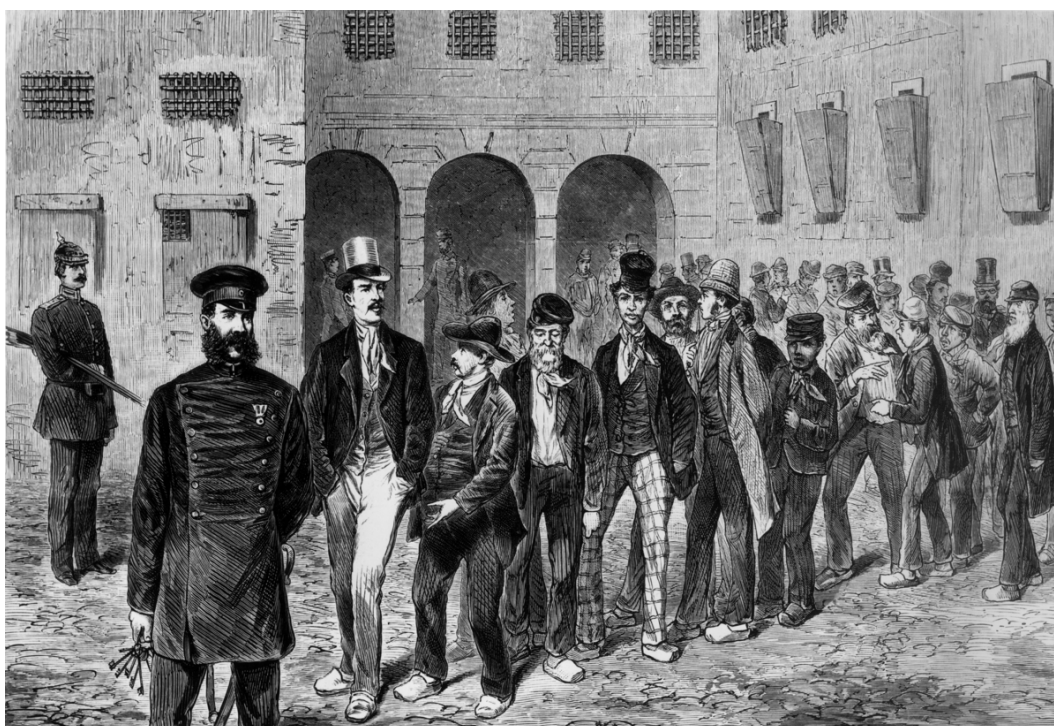


Taking a Morning Walk—in Jail (1880)
