

## The German Booksellers' Bourse in Leipzig (1861)

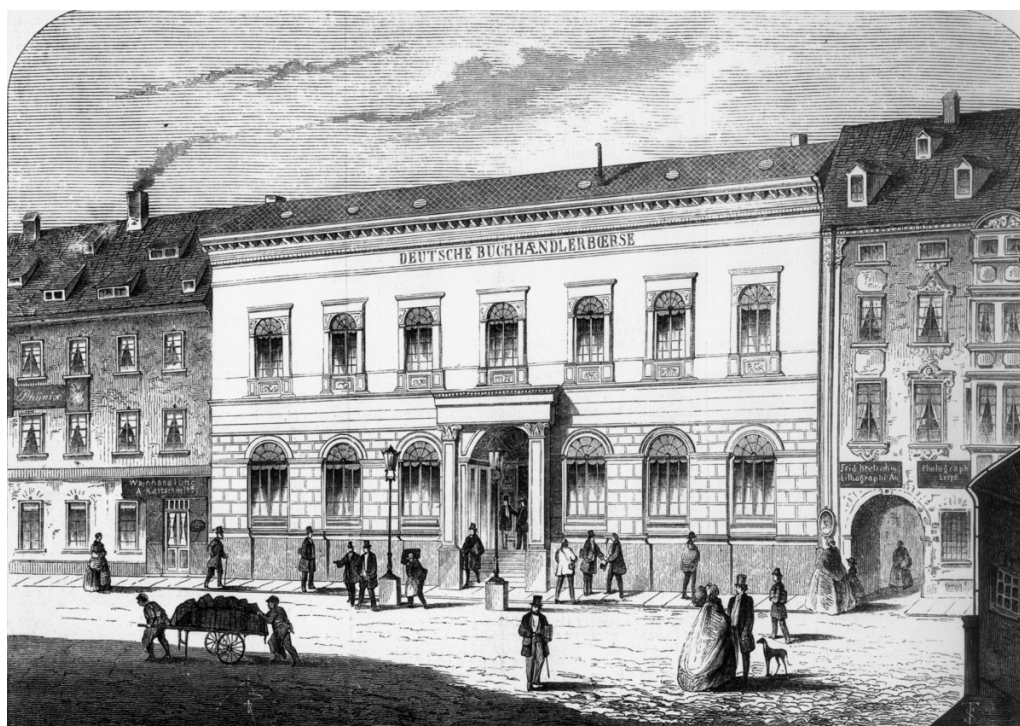
### Abstract
