


## Honorary Delegation of German Regiments at Versailles (January 18, 1871)

## **Abstract**

An early example of photographic reportage, this image contrasts starkly with Anton von Werner's oil painting *A Billet outside Paris*. Here, we see an honorary delegation of German troops at Versailles. The proclamation of Prussian King Wilhelm I as German Emperor [*Kaiser*] took place the same day.
