

Battle of Mühlberg on April 24, 1547 (17th century)

Abstract

At the Battle of Mühlberg on the Elbe River, the combined forces of Emperor Charles V and Duke Moritz of Saxony defeated the Schmalkaldic League. The victory ended the Protestant resistance. This military map shows Charles' victory in the battle.
