

Image Series: "The Dignitaries and Offices of the Roman Church" (2nd half of the 16th century)

Abstract

These woodcuts by Swiss artist Tobias Stimmer form a series portraying the Catholic church hierarchy. In the first image, the pope (left) is identified by his triple-crown (tiara) and his three-barred cross; the cardinal (center) by his large-brimmed, flat hat, and the two-barred cross, and the archbishop by his bishop's hat (right). The cardinal is holding a letter of indulgence bearing three seals.
