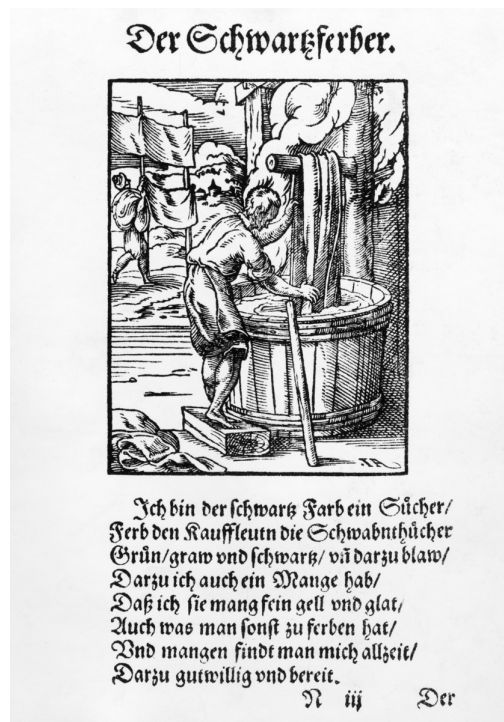


Urban Trades – The Dark Dyer (1568)
