

Barricade Fighting in Front of the Cölln Town Hall on Breite Strasse (in Berlin) on March 18–19, 1848 (1848)

Abstract

By early March, the revolution seemed to have triumphed in Prussia as well. But after shots were fired accidentally on a peaceful crowd that had gathered in front of Prussian king Friedrich Wilhelm IV's palace to cheer his concessions to revolutionary demands, fierce street fighting returned to Berlin.
