Abstract

The Prussian Major General Carl von Clausewitz (1780–1831) was a military reformer and strategist, and one of the leading military thinkers of the nineteenth century. In many respects, Clausewitz's theory of war, put forth in his major work *On War* (1832), represented a paradigmatic shift in military thinking, because it considered the fundamental relationship between war and politics.
