

# German-Danish War: Prussian Troops March through the Brandenburg Gate (1864)

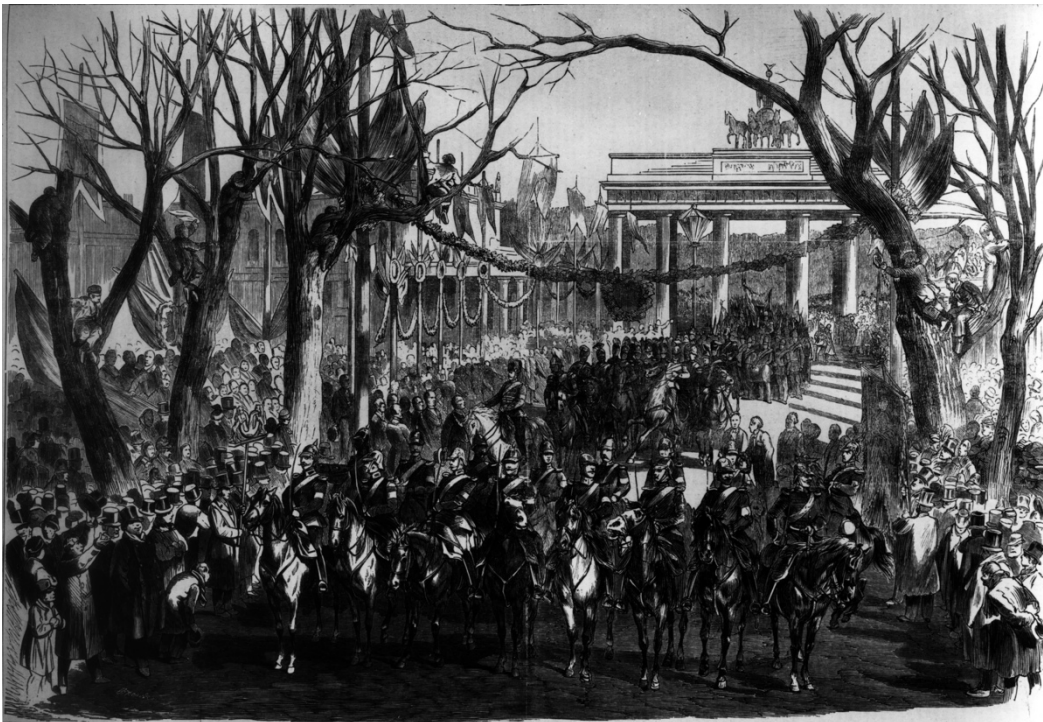
## Abstract

After the victorious conclusion of the German-Danish War, Prussian troops marched through the Brandenburg Gate in Berlin on December 7, 1864.
