

Inaugural Run of the first German Railroad between Nuremberg and Fürth on December 7, 1835 (1835)

Abstract

The Ludwig Railroad, the first railway line in Germany, ran between Nuremberg and Fürth (a distance of 6 km). It made its first trip on December 7, 1835, and operated until 1922. Lithograph after a colored engraving by Conrad Wießner (1796–1865), undated.
