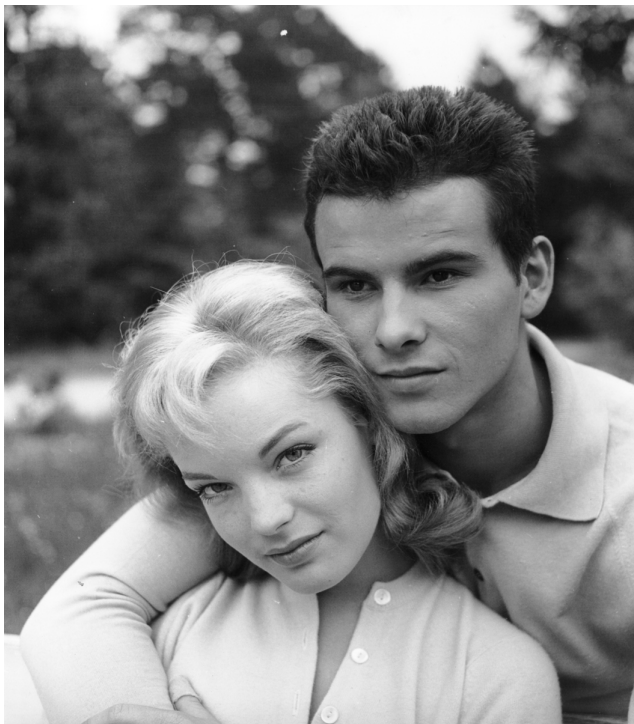


Romy Schneider and Horst Buchholz (1957)
