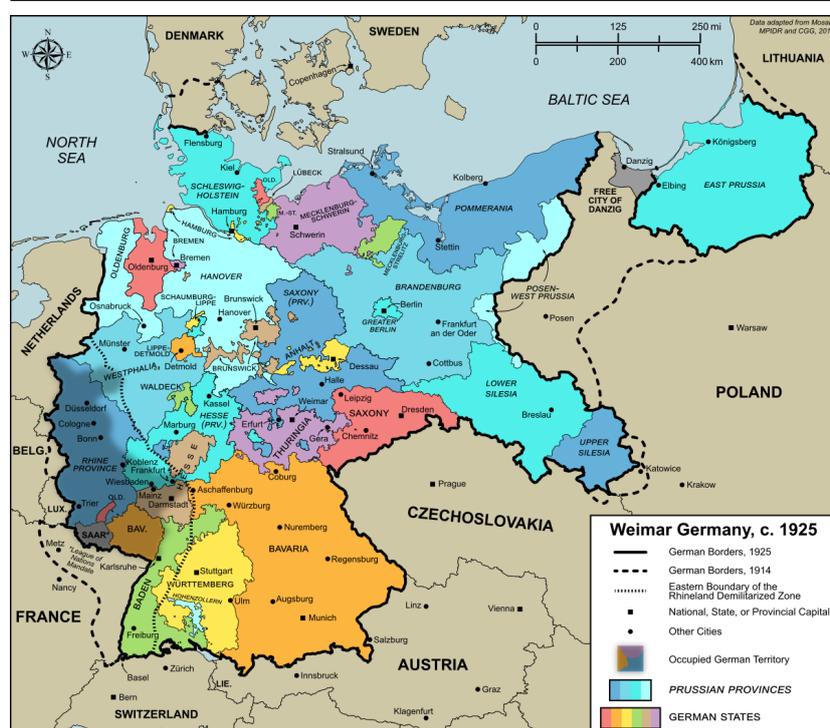


# Weimar Germany (c. 1925)

## Abstract

The Weimar Constitution established a federal parliamentary democratic system with strong states (former federal states, *Bundesstaaten*) that had their own constitutions, parliaments, and administrations. Not only the republic, but also the states [*Länder*] were structured democratically. This map shows the different *Länder* with their respective capitals as well as the Prussian provinces, which functioned like states.
