

## Dancing School (c. 1899)

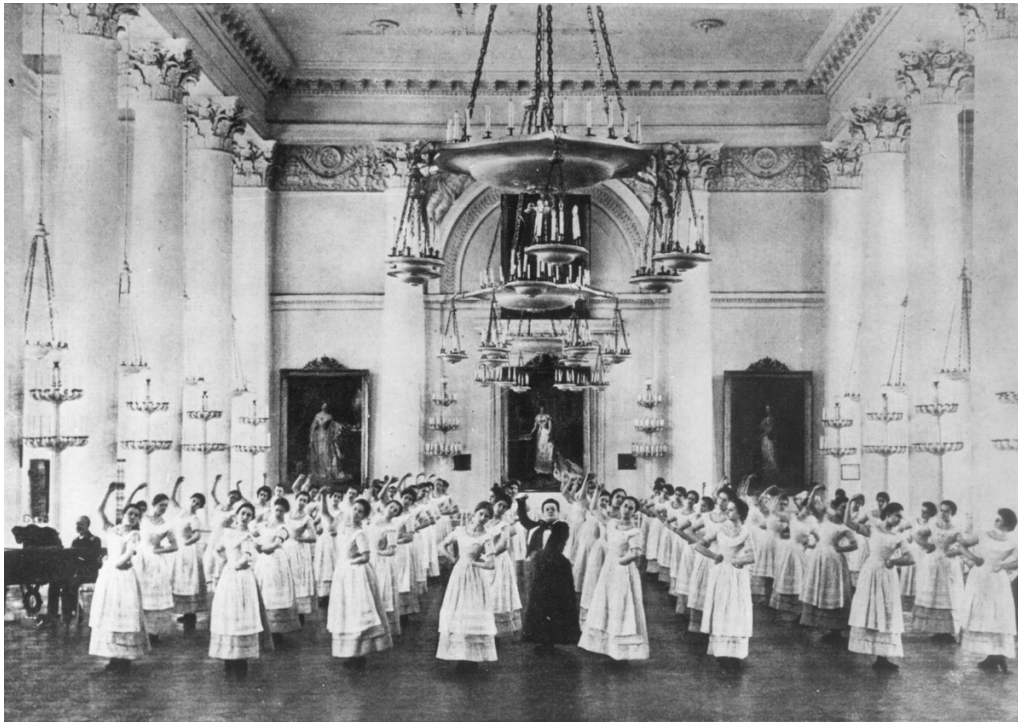
### Abstract
